

# Installing CPM-200 on a LAN using a Static IP Address

IT personnel will need to supply the following information:

- Static IP Address
  - Subnet Mask Address
  - Default Gateway Address
  - Full Administrator rights for the user account on which the driver is being installed
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## 1. Installing the CPM-200 driver.

***\*Do not connect the USB cable until later on in this guide\****

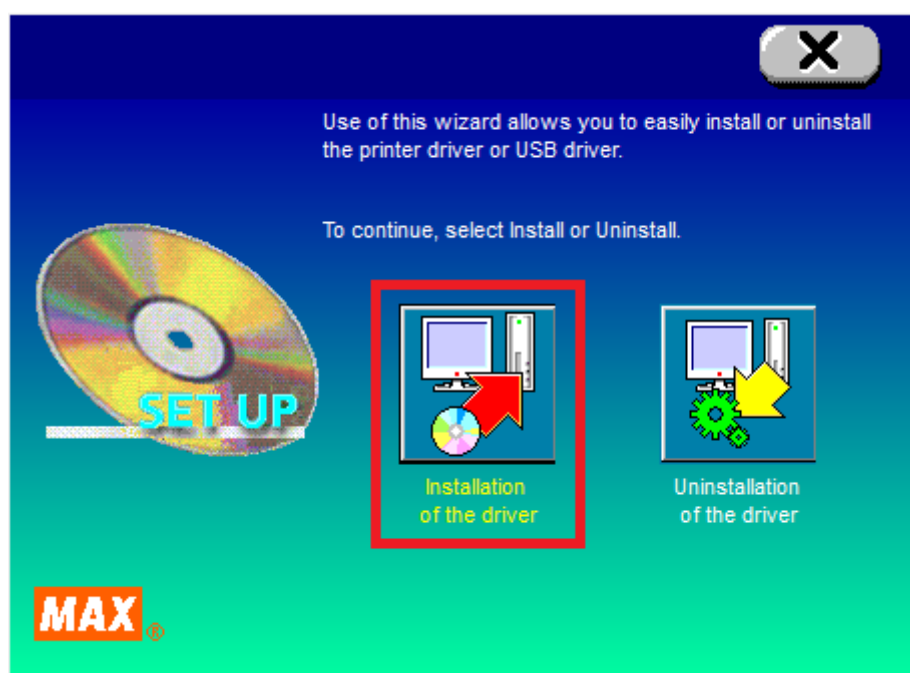
Copy the software folder on the USB drive to the C: Drive of the computer and run the '**Start**' application.



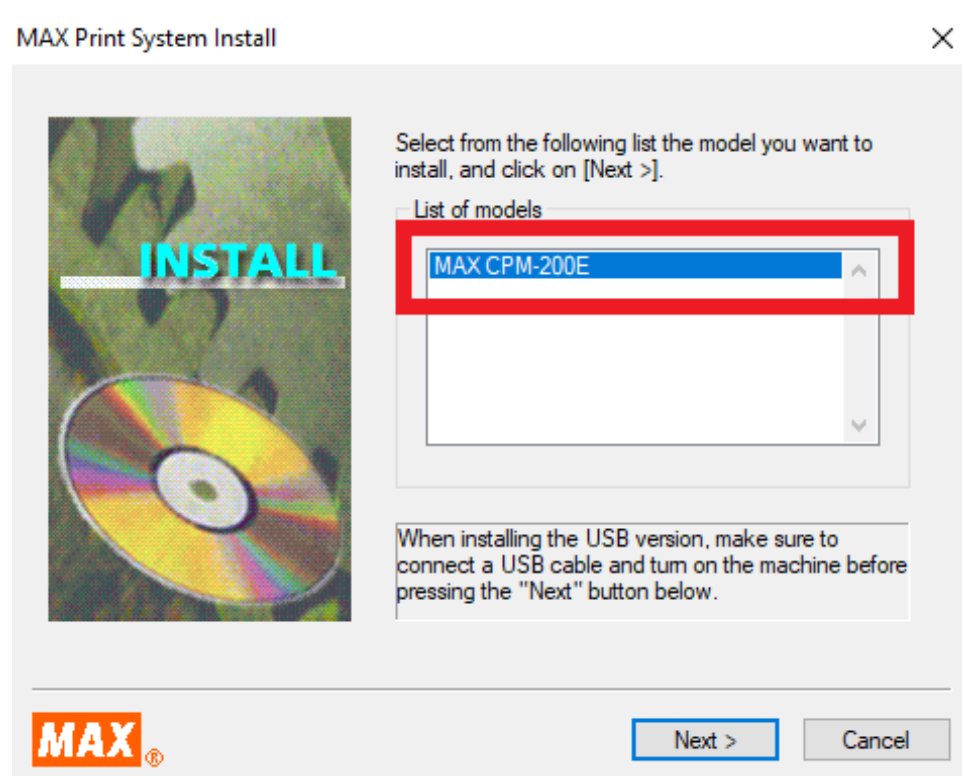
*This is the screen you should see after running the 'Start' application*

Select '**Install CPM-200 printer driver**'.

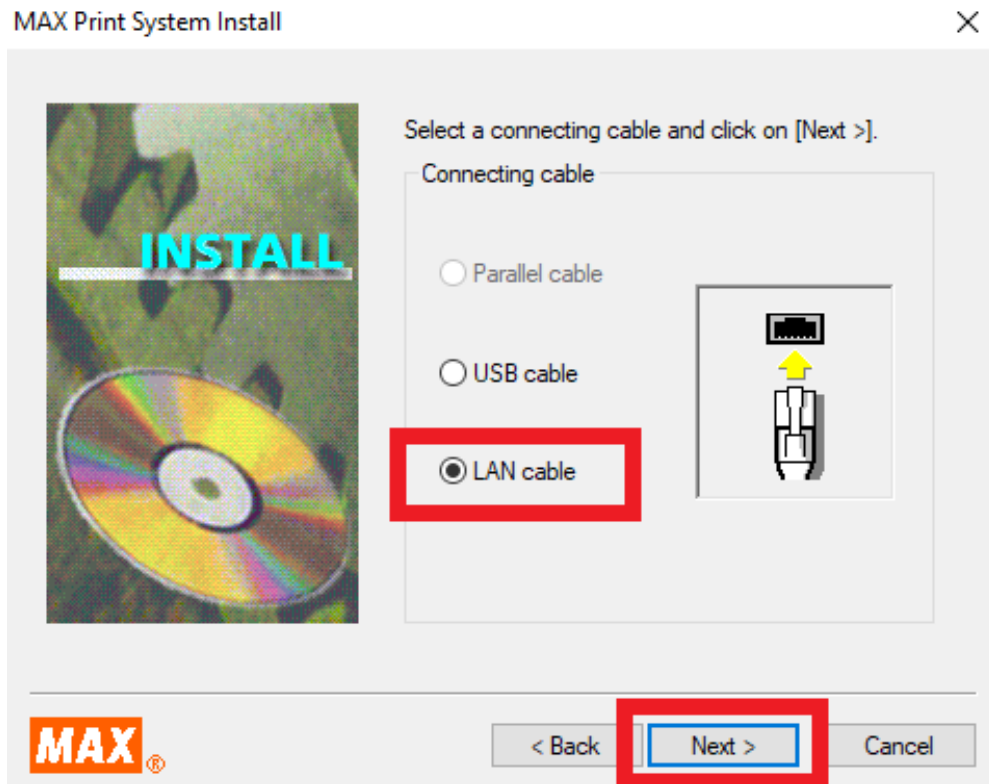
Click on '*Installation of the driver*'.



Select '*MAX CPM-200E*' and click Next.

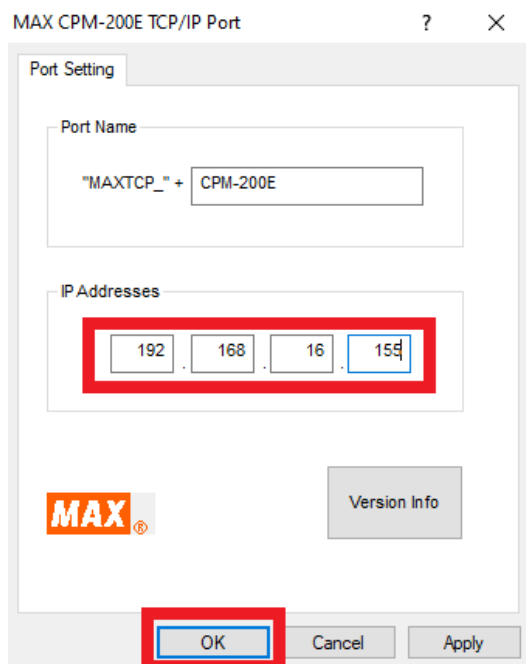


Select on '**LAN cable**' and click Next.



## 2: Assigning Static IP Address to designated printer port.

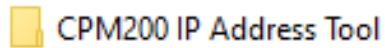
When the dialogue box displayed here appears, enter the static IP address, and then click Apply.



*\*Be sure to enter this correctly, else you will run into problems later on in the process\**

The printer driver will install and you will be prompted to restart your computer, which you should do so '**immediately**'.

3. Using the IP Address Tool – Located in the below folder on USB drive –  
(run MCP200IPS Application)



Connect the CPM-100HG5 via USB cable, turn the printer on and run the '**MCP200IPS**' application (Printer IP Address Setting Tool). The dialogue box displayed below should appear.


*\*Double check that the 'CPM-200E' is selected in the dropdown list\**

Click on '**Find**'. This should reveal the default IP and MAC Addresses of the motherboard.

Click the '**Detailed Settings**' checkbox and enter the following addresses provided by IT personnel:

- IP Address (this is the same as the Static IP Address used in step 2)
- Subnet Mask
- Default Gateway

Finally, click on '**Registration**' and then '**End**'.

## Other Important Notes

- DHCP is not supported
- You cannot print from both a USB cable and network cable simultaneously. If you no longer wish to network the printer and only use the USB cable, the driver must be uninstalled and reinstalled, selecting '**USB cable**' as seen in step 1.
- If you wish to print over the LAN from other laptops/computers, you only need to follow steps 1 & 2.
- '**Use printer offline**' must be **disabled** for the CPM-200 in Printers & Scanners (or Devices and Printers), else the printer will not respond despite the status monitor displaying '*Available to Print*' when printing over a network.
